Are placements paid?

No, all internship placements in Ireland are unpaid.

When are they available?

Spring 4/6 weeks or Summer 4/6/8/12 weeks

What are the work hours?

Full time, generally 9am - 5pm, Monday through Friday. (hours may differ)and can be changed depending on the programme the intern is on.

Check with your University if they can award you credits for your internship in Ireland. Sample sectors International Business, Marketing, Graphic Design, Engineering, IT, Finance, Animation, Film, Environmental, Tourism , Political Science, Social care, if you do not see what you are looking for - contact us we have many more. Students with a US/ Canadian passport do not need to apply for a visa to enter Ireland for stays of up to 90 days.

SHORT TERM SPRING OR SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

4/8/12 weeks **are valuable even though the stay is short, it still affords you the opportunity to live and intern in an European city**

ACCOMMODATION can be arranged with carefully selected Irish host families, students can opt to stay in either twin or single rooms. Breakfast and evening meal are provided as well as internet, laundry etc. Apartments self catering accommodation **can only be arranged during summer months (not available in Spring) and are subject to availability or interns have the choice to arrange their own accommodation and still participate on the programme.**
